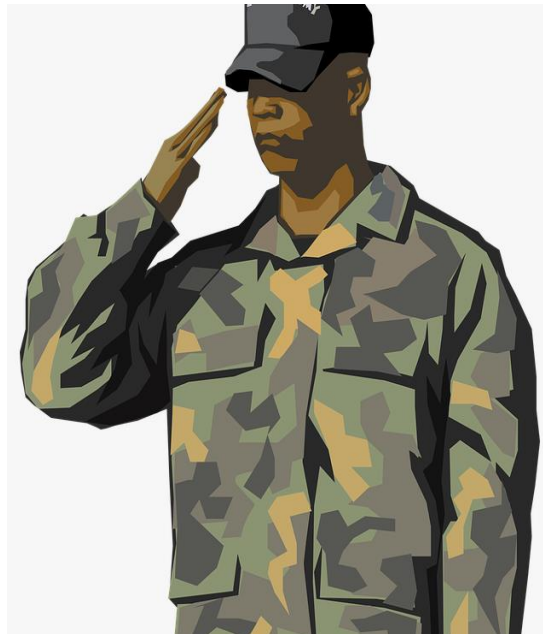
Theo Monod wrote many years ago, "None of Self and All of Thee." That song embodies the heart of Christianity. To give oneself to God is to give one's best.
