## MENTAL HEALTH WORKSHOP

(APRIL 26-28)

An ancient Chinese parable tells of Tan Chang who had a small farm overshadowed by a towering mountain. One day he got the notion to get rid of the mountain. With the help of his wife and sons, he began to hack at the rock around its base. A neighbor walked by and scoffed, "You will never finish the job, old man!
