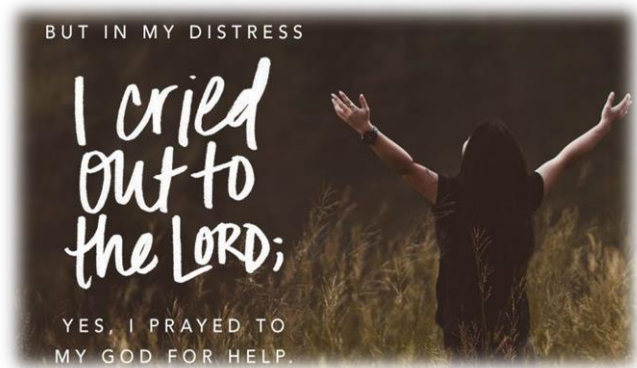
CRY OUT TO THE LORD

"SAM"ANTICS

"For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand" (2 Timothy 4:6)

As Paul wrote, from within a Roman prison, what would be his final inspired letter; the tone takes on a sense of finality. He knows what is facing him (4:6) and a lifetime has been reduced to awaiting the orders to kill him. He faces his future with a sense of having done what God wished of him (4:7) and with an anticipation of receiving a crown of victory (4:8). Yet there are some thoughts and things that weigh heavy on his mind ...

- 1) A good friend (Demas) has deserted him due to fear of facing the same fate that is awaiting Paul (4:9-10).
- 2) Others friends and co-workers have had to go away as well, not out of selfish fear, but; due to their own work in various places (4:10)

But all was not gloom and doom for Paul! His dear friend Luke has stayed by his side. Timothy, and perhaps John Mark, would soon come to see him if possible. He might soon have his precious books and parchments, as well as his warm & comfortable cloak (4:11). Most of all, however, Paul was never alone despite this ordeal he was suffering through! There, unseen, but certainly not out of the picture, was another sustaining blessing: the assurance that Jesus has been with him every step of the way (4:17) giving strength & confidence!!!!
