# PARENTS, WHAT ARE WE TEACHING OUR CHILDREN?

Deut. 6:6-9, "And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."


God's desire for parents according to Malachi 2:15 is to have "godly offspring." This does not just happen. Deut. 6:6-9 teaches that godly offspring comes by teaching and being a model of the Lord's commands to our children in every area of our life. Steve Flatt put it this way, "No single factor will influence a child as much as the example of the parents. If I want my son or my daughter to believe in God and worship Him, my relationship with Him must be strong and personal. If I expect my child to want to go to Sunday school and worship services, I must enjoy going myself and let him know that. If I am seeking to keep my child from a chemical addiction, I must ask myself, "What does my consuming alcohol tell him about what I believe?" His temperament, conduct, and attitudes are going to be much like mine."[i]

He makes a great point and reminds us that our children really know what we value. For example, if I only give my child a dollar for the collection plate on Sunday and later give them \$60.00 to go out with their friends or to buy video games, we may be teaching them a set of values that they will keep the rest of their life as what is more important.

The best way to teach spiritual values is to not only talk about them with your children but also show that you value them too by your actions.
